



MEDICATION TRAYS

CASE SPECIFIC

At the beginning of each case, please lay out the case specific medication trays, along with the code tray. During orientation of the day the team of participants should be informed on how to use the medications and what is expected of them.

In each tray, the fake medications are dyed blue (food coloring used) for safety and are placed in specific locations based on the organizational chart. There is also always a "Drug X" in every tray, just for those moments when a medication is requested that is not in your pre-made tray.

Please use this chart to organize your trays, they can be modified to fit your site's needs.
